EXHIBITS: Our current exhibit features Archies Comics memorabilia of Nancy Silberkleit, co-CEO of Archies Comic Publications. Nancy's father-in-law, Louis Silberkleit, began publishing the Archies Comics in 1941, and when she married his son, she herself developed an interest in collecting Archies memorabilia. She now allows her collection to tour and has graciously offered to let it be shown at the Jeffersontown Historical Museum. The exhibit will run from July 2 – December 14, 2018.

DONATIONS: Robert Lane donated a book and some news clippings on Roscoe Goose. Tara Eddleman donated some c1950s postcards from Martin's Garage addressed to various local residents and a brick from the old Jeffersontown High School that was razed in 1978. The brick is covered in green felt and an embroidered picture of the school – it can currently be seen on display in the museum. Rhonda Rowland, Jeffersontown's Arts Program Manager, managed to secure a wonderful donation of artifacts from the Jeffersontown Police Department, thanks to the help Major Lee Meredith.
