2014 GASLIGHT FESTIVAL DATES AND STREET CLOSINGS



September is a very busy month in Jeffersonton, especially when it comes to the Gaslight Festival. This year's Festival runs from September 14th – 21st. Here are some reminders of the events and road closings during the Festival.

SEPTEMBER 16th -- TUESDAY -- GASLIGHT FESTIVAL RUN/WALK

The Gaslight Run/Walk is Tuesday, September 16th. The Run begins at 7:00 P.M. It starts and ends at City Hall, 10416 Watterson Trail. Please note that besides Watterson Trail, parts of Dell Road, Galene Drive, Ethelwood Way, Willowood Way, Walnutwood Way, and Locust Road will be closed during much of the Run. Also, numerous streets within the run perimeter

will have periodic closings during the event. Taylorsville Road traffic will not be affected by this event. Please watch out for runners and walkers.

SEPTEMBER 18th -- THURSDAY -- GASLIGHT FESTIVAL PARADE

The Gaslight Parade is Thursday, September 18th. It starts at 6:00 P.M., Jeffersonton Commons Center, 9500 block of Taylorsville Road. Taylorsville Road between Gleeson Lane and Merioneth Drive will shut down at 5:30 P.M. The parade route is Taylorsville Road eastbound to Watterson Trail south and ends on College Drive.

SEPTEMBER 19th - 21st - FRIDAY, SATURDAY, SUNDAY--GASLIGHT FESTIVAL

The Annual Gaslight Festival begins on Friday, September 19th. Roadways will be shut down starting at 4:30 P.M. The roadways affected are:

- Watterson Trail at Old Taylorsville Road to South Watterson Trail at Billtown Road will be closed.
- Taylorsville Road at Ruckriegel Parkway will be closed.
- Taylorsville Road at Peach Street will be closed.
- Taylorsville Road is completely shut down between Ruckriegel Parkway and Jefferson Street. You cannot get through. Use Ruckriegel Parkway as a bypass.
- College Drive at Peach Street to College Drive and Watterson Trail will be closed.

Please make arrangements for alternate routes around the city.

The Gaslight Festival finishes on Sunday, September 21st at 5:00 P.M. Taylorsville Road and Watterson Trail should be opened to normal traffic by 8:00 P.M. that evening.
