Do you know what to do if you are involved in a traffic collision?

Here is some information you should remember:

Be prepared – have your vehicle registration and insurance information in a safe place in your car. Keep a list of emergency phone numbers, (insurance agent, family members, child(s) school etc). You may consider a list of medical conditions, medications or allergies for all family members. This information may be valuable if you are injured in a collision. Keep a blank pad of paper and pen/pencil in your vehicle.

- Don't leave the scene
- Call the police, ask for an ambulance if you or someone else needs one
- Get the officer(s) name, badge number and the report number
- Ask the officer for information about when and how the report can be picked up
- Write down the date and time of collision
- Write down the street and city of the collision
- Make note of weather and/or road conditions
- Write a brief description of what happened and draw a diagram
- Get the name(s), address and phone numbers of all people involved and witnesses
- Write down the license plate numbers of all vehicles involved

This information should be included on the report, however your insurance company may need some or all of this information sooner to get the claim started. If you choose to settle the accident without the use of your insurance company, you may need this information.
